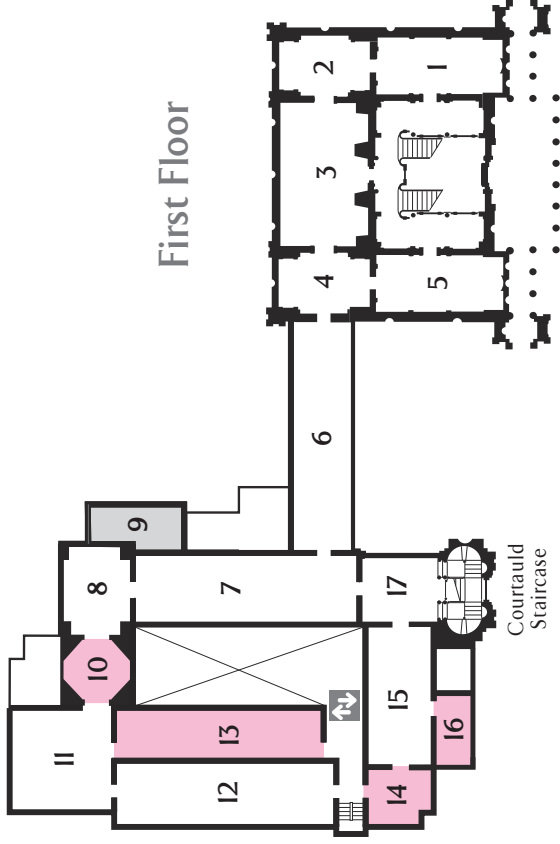
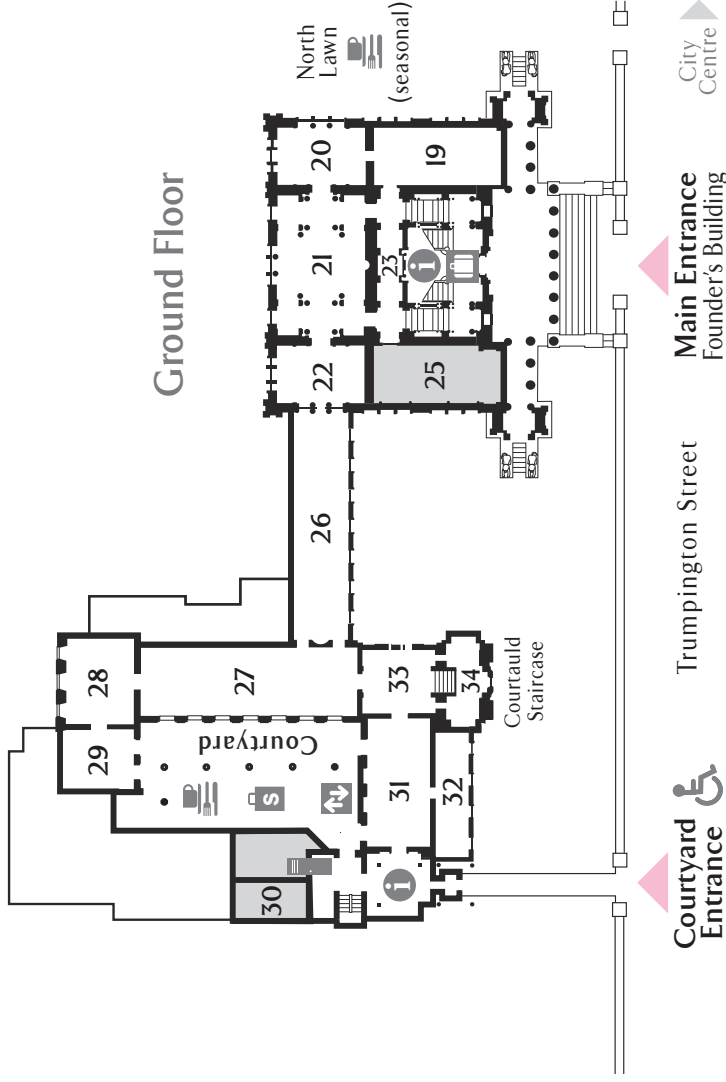

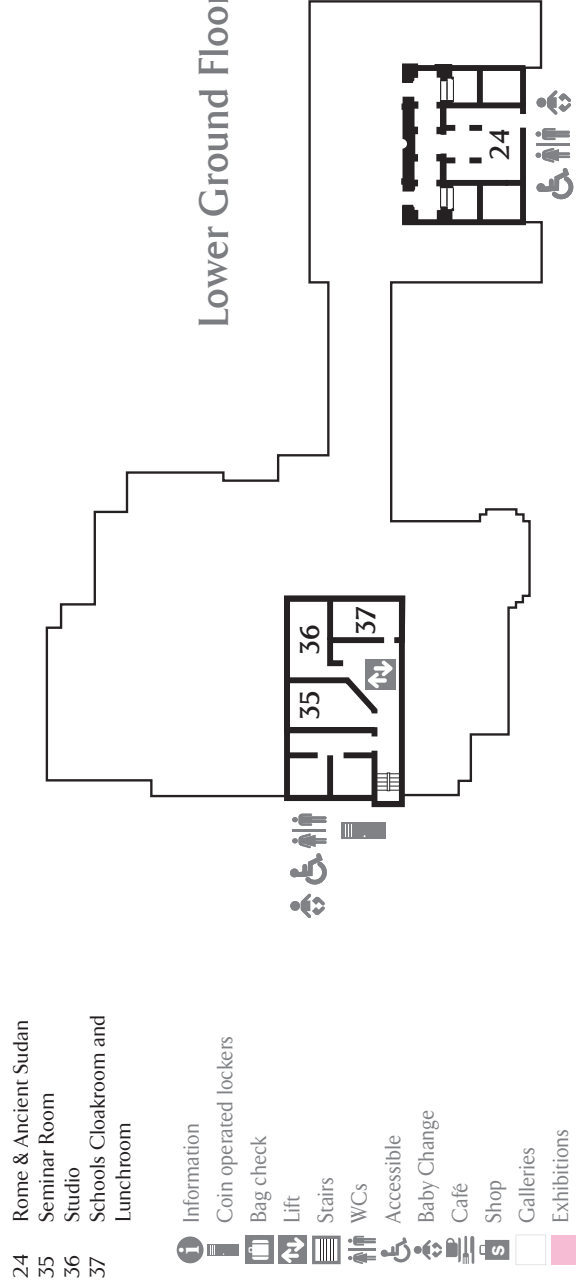

This leaflet provides information to help you make the most of your visit. If there is anything else you need to know, or in the event of an emergency, please ask a member of staff for assistance.

**Admission is free** Visitors are invited to make donations which help keep the galleries open and are much appreciated.

**What's On guide** provides details of the Museum's exhibitions and events programme.

**Personal item storage** There are coin operated lockers at the South Entrance for coats and personal items. The main entrance also provides a manned bag check. The Museum does not accept large items of luggage and does not accept responsibility for items left in the lockers or bag check.

**The Courtyard Café** serves an all-day menu including morning coffee, afternoon tea, sandwiches and light lunches. **The North Lawn Café** serves refreshments in an *al fresco* setting from March to October, weather permitting. Cafés close 30 minutes before the Museum.

**The Courtyard Shop** sells a wide range of postcards, greetings cards, art books, jewellery and giftware inspired by the collections. The Shop closes 15 minutes before the Museum.
